MIDDLE SCHOOL

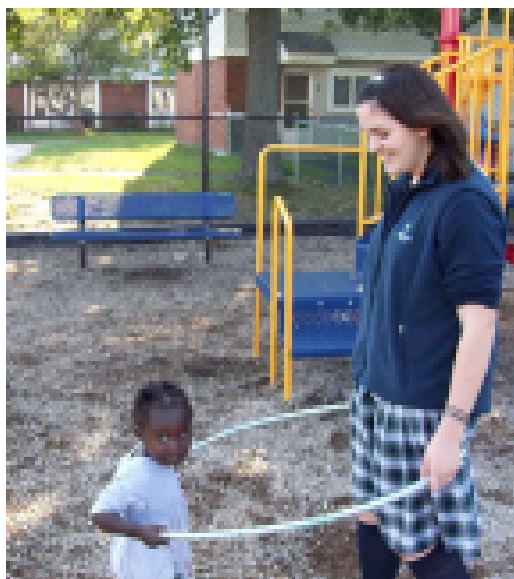
